Black and White Historic photographs	Public Hearing Rooms (East and West Wings)	Black and white reproduction photographs from the Idaho State Archives collections. Images reflect the Committees assigned to the Public Hearing Room.
Abraham Lincoln portrait	West Wing, outside Lincoln Auditorium	Painting from the original 1863 chromolithograph in a large gold frame.
Governing Idaho: How People and Politics Shape Our State exhibit	Garden Level Rotunda	Exhibit illustrating through graphics and artifacts the governmental history of Idaho.
USS Boise CL-47 ship photograph	Garden Level Welcome Room	Wood framed color photo of USS Boise CL-47 ship. Back has faded note and stamp that says "Official United States Navy Photograph."
USS Idaho BB-42 ship photograph	Garden Level Welcome Room	Wood framed photo of USS Idaho BB-42 ship. Back has note and stamp that says "Official United States Navy Photograph."
Winged Victory of Samothrace sculpture	4th floor rotunda by Statuary Hall entry	"Winged Victory of Samothrace," arrived on the "Merci Train" (Thank you train) donated by City of Paris 2/22/49. Large plaster sculpture of a winged female figure.
George Washington Equestrian sculpture	4th floor rotunda by Statuary Hall entry	George Washington mounted on a horse sculpted by Charles L. Ostner and donated to the Territory of Idaho in 1869. White pine gilded gold.
Governors portraits (30)	2nd floor, West Wing (outside Governor's Office)	Black and white framed pictures of Idaho's governors from Shoup to Otter.
State Seal painting	2nd floor, East Wing (Secretary of State's Office)	Large square color painting of Idaho State Seal.
Legislative portraits (105)	4th floor Chamber areas, 3rd floor Chamber areas, and new Garden Level Wings (Public Hearing	Senate and House legislative composites by session and year. Oldest (1893) composites can be found on the 4th floor and progresses to recent sessions on the 3rd floor and Wings.
