CAPITOL COMMISSION APPOINTS DOUGLAS DORN AS FINANCIAL ADVISOR

Roy Lewis Eiguren, Chairman of the Idaho Capitol Commission, announced today the appointment of Boise investment management executive, Douglas Dorn, as Financial Advisor to the Idaho Capitol Commission.
